Conditions for filming permit

3. The applicant(s) will report to the Executive Director or designated representative of Gobabeb on the same day as s/he/they enter the Namib-Naukluft Park.
4. The applicant(s) will pay all fees and abide by payment conditions per prior agreement with Gobabeb.
5. The applicant(s) will keep Gobabeb informed of all activities and movements within the Institute's research area and needs to obtain permission to travel off official roads. No driving off established tracks will be permitted.
6. The applicant(s) will adhere to all Gobabeb rules and best practices as regards ethics and environmental protection; and carry this document with them when away from the Institute.
7. The applicant(s) will comply with all MET Park rules, particularly those regarding the use of drones in protected areas
